- Open Houses**

- Application**  
Please return the completed application form to the Admission Office with the \$125 non-refundable application fee and a recent family photograph by Dec. 15.
- Independent School Entrance Exam (ISEE)**  
Please arrange to have your child take the ISEE exam. Testing dates and locations enclosed. Be sure to list Wildwood's school number 054122 in order for results to be sent to us.
- Transcript**  
Please give the Transcript Release Form to the applicant's current school.
- Teacher Recommendations**  
Please give the Teacher Recommendation Forms to **three** current teachers of academic subjects (humanities, language if applicable, and math or science). Forms are to be mailed directly from the school in the provided envelopes.
- Administrator Recommendation Form**  
Please submit this form to the principal or director of the applicant's current school. The form is to be mailed directly from the school in the provided envelopes.
- Parent/Guardian and Student Interview**  
Wildwood interviews all applicant families. We will contact you to schedule an interview once the completed application has been received by the Admission Office and the Open House requirement has been met.
- Student Project**  
Student applicants are required to bring an academic project to the interview and be prepared to discuss it.
  - This project should reflect a sustained interest and must be the student's own work.
  - Any equipment necessary to the presentation is the responsibility of the student.
