If your student fails the wellness check, they will be flagged in the system

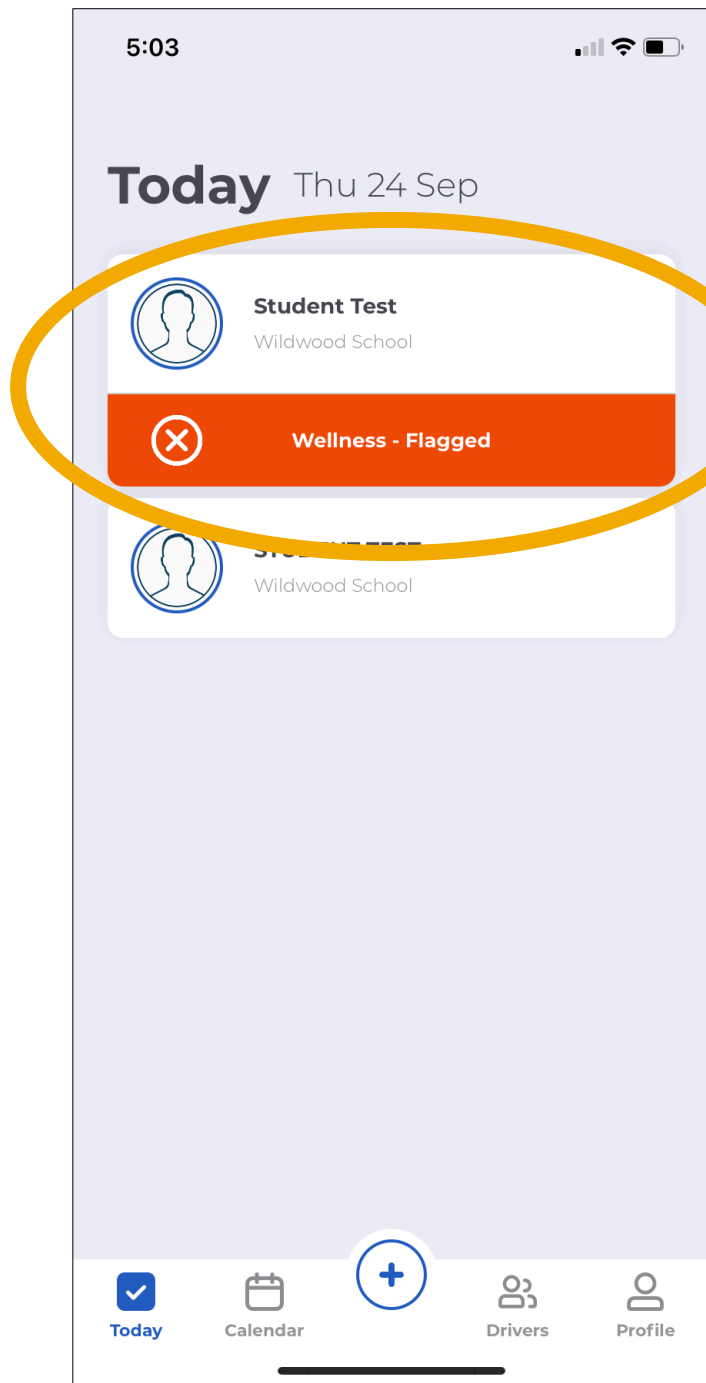

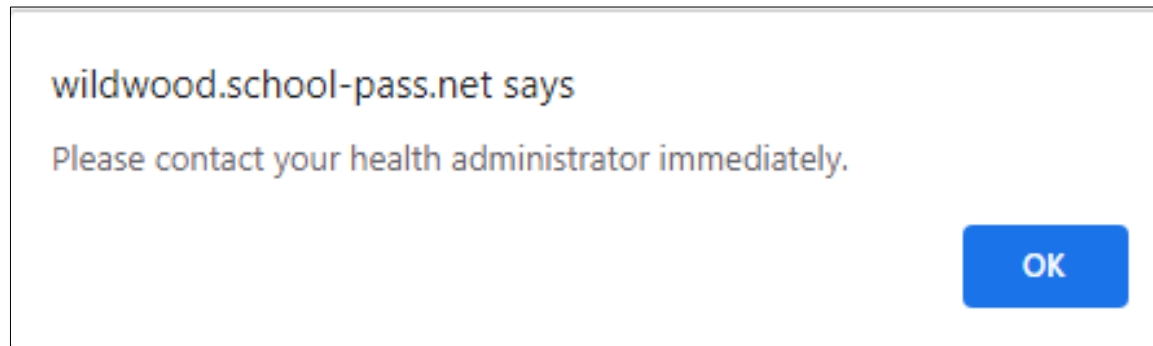

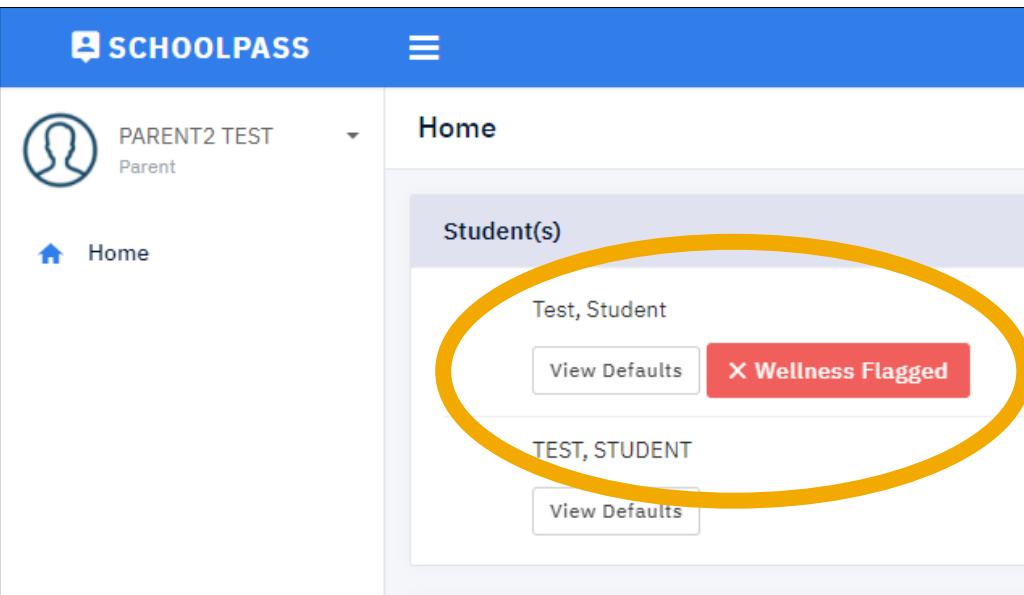
